| Tree Descriptions & Site Suitability | | 75% to 80% Survival Rate – All trees & shrubs sold are to be used for effective conservation practices such as windbreaks, erosion control, etc., and will not be planted for ornamental purposes. | HYBRID CHESTNUT | 100' | Rapid growing hardwood, good source of nuts for wildlife. | Porous soils, sandy soils | Full Sun |
| CHINESE CHESTNUT | 20-25' | Dense round headed ornamental trees bear large sweet edible nuts, self-fertile but best to plant two or more. Should start bearing in 3 to 5 years. Blight resistant. | Deep sandy loam soils | Full Sun |
| AMERICAN HAZELNUT | 10-15' | Medium growth rate, small multi-stemmed tree that produces edible nuts in September to October. Also known as American Filbert. | Adaptable to well-drained | Prefers Full Sun |
| SHAGBARK HICKORY | 80-90' | Narrow upright growth habit, yellow to golden brown leaves in fall; has sweet edible nuts in 25 to 30 years, characterized by its "shedding bark". | Adaptable | Full Sun |
| AUSTRIAN PINE | 50-60' | Spread of 20' to 40'. Stiff dark green needles 3 to 6 inches long, very tolerant of dry rocky conditions and roadside salt, dense pyramidal growth good for screens or windbreaks. | Ordinary to poor soil | Full Sun |
| BALSAM FIR | 50-70' | Statuesque form, excellent Christmas tree. Good wildlife nesting tree. | Tolerates wide range of moist soils | Partial Sun Prefers North Face |
| CANAAN FIR | 40-55' | Spread of 20' to 25' dense pyramidal shape, short soft needles highly adaptable to many soil conditions, great Christmas tree, thrives in cooler climates. | Adaptable to a range of soils | Full Sun to Full Shade |
| CONCOLOR FIR | 100' | Soft silvery blue needles, make it excellent for Christmas trees. | Well drained soils a must | Full Sun to Partial Shade |
| EASTERN REDBUD | 20-30' | Spreads 25' to 30' known for their reddish purple buds and flowers in early spring, large dark green heart shaped leaves. | Well-drained | Full Sun |
| DOUGLAS FIR | 100' | Soft, blue-green needles, fast-growing; windbreaks, Christmas trees, timber. | Sandy loam, well-drained | Full Sun |
| FRASER FIR | 30-60' | Needles are soft dark green. Excellent Christmas tree, fast grower when young. | Well drained & moist | Partial Shade or North Face |
| HIGHBUSH BLUEBERRY | 6-12' | Duke: Early-season with late bloom, good fruit size, winter hardy. Blue Crop: Mid-season, high yields, good disease resistance, extremely hardy. | Moist, well-drained | Full Sun to Partial Shade |
| RED MULBERRY | 30-50' | Spreads 20' to 40' prefers warm well drained soils but very adaptable to many condition, fruits are a favorite of many birds and people; excellent for jams, juice and wine. | Well drained to adaptable | Shade Tolerant |
| AMERICAN SYCAMORE | 75-100' | Fast growing, with wide spreading crown, great for shade, bark peels in thin irregular patches, giving a white appearance to trunk. | Likes moist soils along streams | Full Sun to Shade |
| RIVER BIRCH | 70-80' | Multi-stem trunk. Bark vanes from reddish brown to black as tree ages. Good riparian shade tree. | Moist to wet | Grows best in Full Sun |
| RED RASPBERRIES | 6-8' | Heritage variety, moderate to fast growing. | Well drained | Full Sun |
| BIRD-BUTTERFLY MIX | Flower blend designed to attract Hummingbirds and Butterflies all summer long. | | | |
| LOW MAINTNENANCE MIX | Designed to thrive in less than ideal conditions yet still add beauty. | | | |
| BEE FEED-POLLINATOR | Varieties included to attract bees and other helpful pollinating insects. | | | |
| SULFUR | Soil amendment for Blueberries and other acid loving plants. Sulfur helps to lower the pH of the soil for plants that require highly acid soils (pH range of 4.5 to 5.5); such as blueberries, azaleas & rhododendrons. | | | |
| FERTILIZER TABLETS | Use 1 tablet per 1/4" stem diameter. One tablet for seedlings, two for transplants. | | | |
